COFFEEHOUSE MYSTERIES by Cleo Laine
What’s on the menu at the Village Blend Coffeehouse in New York’s Greenwich Village? Espresso, Lattes, Muffins...and Murder! Clare Cosi is the store manager and amateur sleuth.

TEA SHOP MYSTERIES by Laura Childs
Set in the Indigo Tea Shop in Charleston, South Carolina, these mysteries showcase the talents of Theodosia Browning.

WINE LOVERS MYSTERIES by Michele Scott
Nikki Sands is a California waitress who gets offered a job in a vineyard. Stories include food and wine pairings.

CATERING MYSTERIES by Isis Crawford
Sisters Bernie and Libby Simmons own A Little Taste of Heaven Catering and Bake Shop in Longely, New York.

Featuring Chloe Carter (known in chat rooms as Gourmet Girl), food connoisseur and survivor of failed romances.

PENNSYLVANIA DUTCH MYSTERIES by Tamar Myers
Set in Pennsylvania, this series features Magdalena Yoder, an Amish-Mennonite sleuth who runs a bed and breakfast in the mythical town of Hernia.

CANDY SHOP MYSTERIES by Sammi Carter
Abby Shaw has returned to her hometown of Paradise, Colorado—leaving behind a career in corporate law and a cheating husband—to take over her aunt’s candy shop, Divinity. Soon she is solving mysteries around town.

CHOCOHOLIC MYSTERIES by Joanna Carl
The chocoholic Mysteries feature Lee McKinney, a Texas beauty queen transplanted to a Michigan resort. Nearly six feet tall and a half-Dutch natural blonde, Lee is often underestimated because she tends to get her “tang toungeled” when she’s nervous. In addition to a mystery, the books feature a behind-the-scenes look at the business and art of making fine, European-style bonbons, truffles and molded chocolates.

CORINNA CHAPMAN MYSTERIES by Kerry Greenwood
Australian Corinna Chapman, baker extraordinaire, runs the Earthly Delights Bakery and has many adventures involving murder, mayhem and mystery.
