WHAT IS THE SERVICE? HOME BORROWERS SERVICE brings library materials to home-bound customers on a regular basis.

WHO CAN USE THIS SERVICE? Any library customer who can not come to the library due to illness or lack of transportation can sign up.

WHAT DOES A VOLUNTEER NEED? An hour or two a month, a car and a willingness to help others in our community.

WHAT DOES A VOLUNTEER DO? Each volunteer will serve as a link between the library and a homebound customer. You'll select materials for that customer and deliver them on a pre-arranged, mutually agreeable schedule.

HOW WILL I KNOW WHAT TO SELECT FOR MY HOME BORROWER? Your Home Borrower will have filled out a Customer Profile, listing his or her interest, reading preferences and some favorite authors, and you'll be talking with your Home Borrower on a regular basis. You'll also be trained by the library.
