



NJ FamilyCare is a federal and state funded health insurance program (including CHIP, Medicaid, and Medicaid expansion populations) created to help qualified New Jersey residents of any age access affordable health insurance. NJ FamilyCare is for people who do not have employer insurance.

Enrollment

People can enroll in NJ FamilyCare at any time throughout the year.

Who is Eligible?

Those eligible for NJ FamilyCare can include children, pregnant women, parents/caretaker relatives, single adults and childless couples. Financial eligibility will be determined by the latest federal tax return which, when filed, will be electronically verified.
