Save the Dates! Prom Dress Giveaway Multiple Dates & Locations Through April

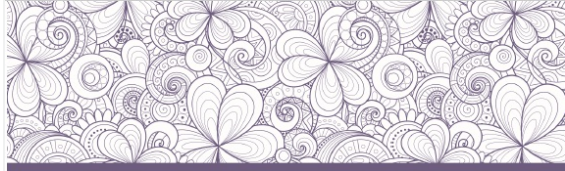
