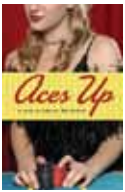




Stories about Lies for Teens

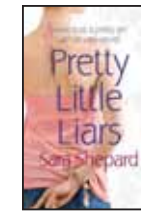
Harmless
