Book Page Wreath Instructions

- Using the circle template, trace and cut a 5 inch and a 7.5 inch circle out of cardboard. Then set them aside.
- Using the square template, trace and cut 15 of the 4 inch squares and 15 of the 6 inch squares out of book pages. Then set them aside.
- Using the spiral template, trace and cut a spiral out of a book page.
- Create cones out of the 4 and 6 inch squares, taping at the seams.
- Using the spiral that was cut earlier, start rolling it from the outside, as shown in the video. Let the spiral open in the palm of your hand, creating a book page rose for the center of the wreath.
- Glue the paper rose to hold it together, as shown in the video.
- Glue the larger paper cones to the 7.5 inch cardboard circle, as shown (seam side down).
- Glue the smaller paper cones to the 5 inch cardboard circle, as shown (seam side down).
- Glue the smaller cardboard circle to the center of the larger paper cones and press firmly.
- Apply some glue to the center of the wreath to attach the paper rose to the center.
- Cut 10 inches of ribbon and glue together as shown in the video. Then glue the ribbon to the edge of the cardboard. This will allow you to hang the wreath.
- You can leave your Book Page Wreath as is, or you can add embellishments such as glitter, beads, buttons, ribbon, etc.
